## **BUYER'S RESPONSIBILITY:**

Herein this document, the name 'Breeder' and 'Seller' will refer to Robertson's Retrievers and Doodles.

- 1. Choose a veterinarian and take your puppy for a wellness examination within **three business days** of leaving *Robertson's Retrievers and Doodles*. Failure to do so renders the *Health Guarantee* null and void.
  - A. Schedule future appropriate veterinary appointments for your puppy to remain healthy and remain updated on all vaccinations throughout its lifetime.
  - B. Avoid your puppy coming into contact with any unvaccinated canine before having its full veterinarian recommended vaccination series, including rabies, distemper, parvovirus, bordetella, etc.
  - C. Puppies are susceptible to ailments upon transitioning to its new home. Urinary tract infections, parasites, and ear infections are common in young puppies. You are responsible for treating and caring for your puppy once it leaves the Breeder's home.

- 2. We recommend waiting until your puppy is one to two years old to be spayed/neutered; females must have gone through at least one heat cycle. Early spay/neuter before 12 months of age (both males and females) & before a female's first heat cycle voids the *Health Guarantee*. Early spay/neuter has been found to increase the risks of joint disorders, impact urinary health, and increase cancer. The heat cycle for females releases hormones beneficial for bladder maturity, joint health, and overall development. Your veterinarian's discretion on timing for spaying/neutering should be followed to allow proper development, particularly among females.
  - A. After your puppy is spayed/neutered, you must notify the Breeder (via email or business mail) with proof of the procedure from your veterinarian for the seller to update the sale's record.
- 3. Your puppy is not for resale. The Breeder and Buyer agree that the purchased puppy is being acquired as a family companion and living within a comfortable home. The Buyer agrees that the puppy will never be used or trained for illegal activities. Also, a female may not be bred without breeding rights purchased from the Breeder.
- 4. The Breeder's puppies sell as **'non-breedable'** with an option to purchase breeding rights. All puppies sold without breeding rights must complete #2 as outlined above, or failure to do so will terminate your *Health Guarantee*, considered a breach of contract, and a fine can be assessed.
- 5. Except for a severe genuine health problem covered within the *Health Guarantee*, there will be **NO REFUNDS**.
